**Scope of Work:**

The Community Education and Training Department of TurnAround, Inc. is seeking an individual to join our team in providing services to victims of domestic violence, human trafficking and sexual assault. The ideal candidate has exceptional public speaking skills, and a knowledge of sexual assault prevention strategies. Position is full-time (40 hours/week) and includes benefits.

**Duties and Responsibilities:**

This position will change and shift as needed, but the following are the core responsibilities that include:

- Strong public speaking and presentation skills with a variety of audiences;
- Knowledge of bystander intervention and sexual assault prevention strategies;
- Compelling desire to work with youth, particularly teens to develop community level strategies to preventing sexual violence;
- Assisting in the development and delivery of trainings and workshops for professionals, college students, community members, and youth (k-12) to address sexual violence;
- Assisting with marketing and outreach initiatives within Baltimore City and County;
- Assisting with the planning of annual awareness events during Sexual Assault and Domestic Violence Awareness months;
- Ability to communicate awareness campaigns through social media platforms is an asset;
- Develop and sustain relationships with community agencies to support sexual assault prevention and intervention efforts;
- Representing TurnAround, Inc. at community events (ex: health fairs);

Qualifications include but aren't limited to:

- Bachelor's Degree in related field.
- Experience working with school aged youth (K-12).
- Ability to work independently within a given framework and handle multiple tasks.
